## **Evangelical Christian Conference – 31st Jan & 1st Feb 2019**

As I was thinking about what to write for February's spiritual notes, I could not conceal my excitement and great anticipation when I heard about the conference in Ethiopia and so, as men and women gather to hear the first reformed Christian conference, I feel it is only apt for us to also consider the same themes that dominates our own churches in the UK. Below I have copied extracts written about the conference which I trust will enthuse and excite us as we too consider about tuning into God's amazing and glorious purposes in the Gospel and church of his Son.

Milkias writes, "In this two day conference, they will be exploring the outworking of God's purposes on earth through the gospel and the church. The victorious reign of Christ over sin and death is manifest today in the redeemed community who know love, obey him and await his glorious return. The community of the redeemed is the church of Christ, scattered across the nations. The miracle of God's saving power through the gospel is seen in redeemed local communities of his people – local churches. Set in an unbelieving and hostile world, each local church needs the power of God to grow and impact their community for Jesus Christ."

How can churches impact their communities for Christ with the power of God? How do you plant and grow churches? How can you strengthen a weak church and enabling it to grow and become strong? How do you recognise a healthy church? And how can you play an active part in your church for your good and God's glory? The Bible has the answers. And so we as a church at FEC pray that the same longing and desire to proclaim Jesus and grow disciples will be our own vision lived out in this our local church.
