

RISK ASSESSMENT

TO ENSURE THAT THE PREMISES OF FELTHAM EVANGELICAL CHURCH, MANOR LANE, FELTHAM ARE COVID 19 SECURE AND THEREFORE SUITABLY SAFE TO BE USED BY THE CHURCH

This assessment has due regard to the “COVID-19 Guidance for the safe use of places of worship” published by Ministry of Housing, Communities and local Government and last updated on 16th July 2021.

GOAL

- To facilitate Feltham Evangelical Church physically joining together for fellowship, worship and service.
- To arrange things so as to ensure the safety of all, whilst all enjoy the privilege of being together again.
- To operate so as to mitigate the risk of the church becoming a source of people being contaminated with Covid-19 and the church being a source of spreading Covid-19.

USE OF BUILDING

- Seating in the Rear Hall and the Main Church to be laid out so as to maximize the spread of chairs so that as many as possible can occupy the building and be at the services.
- Sanitizer is to be placed at the entrance door.
- External windows and internal doors (except doors to toilets) to the building to be left open so as to allow ventilation and avoid multiple use of handles.
- Everyone is encouraged to adopt good hygiene standards by using the sanitizer which will be provided throughout the building.
- By each sink in the toilets there will be a sign showing good handwashing practice.
- Those attending are encouraged, as much as possible, to converse and socialize outside the building between and after the services.
- If the main church is deemed by the stewards to be "full" then people are encouraged to sit in rear hall and listen to service.

AFTER USE

- The building to be cleaned regularly in line with our normal practice

GENERAL

- Anyone showing symptoms associated with COVID-19 should not attend the services
