Spiritual Notes

Are you Saved?

There is no more important question that you face than this. The question is: "Are you saved?" And your answer determines your eternal destiny. The promise to Joseph was given upon the Lord Jesus being conceived in the womb of Mary, in these words: **She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.** And when the converted Samaritans heard the message of salvation from the Lord they say to the Samaritan lady, who originally brought the message, "**It is no longer because of what you said that we believe, for we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this is indeed the Saviour of the world**" (John 4:42). Jesus Christ is the Saviour, the only Saviour, of the world.

So are you saved? To which question there could be three replies: "Yes", "No", or "Not sure". Let us address ourselves to each of those responses.

<u>YES</u> If you can answer "yes" then you must Praise God. Of course you must praise God because God has saved you in Jesus and through Jesus. So in Ephesians 2:8-10 we read: For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. Our salvation is all of God and from God and so we praise Him.

But more than this vio would tell us that we must live for Him. There are good works which have been prepared for us to walk in.

NO Perhaps your answer is "No", though. And as you hear about being saved you respond by saying that "I don't know what it is to be saved." Or "I did not know I had to be saved". Let us be clear here you need to be saved. "Yes, but why, you may ask?" So let us run through why you need to be saved. There is a God who is holy, beautiful and righteous. This God exists in the harmony of Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We, ourselves were created in His image so as to reflect Him and be for him. Alas we turned from Him and chose our own way; we sinned. "So what?" you say.

This is an outrage; it is the ultimate treachery that we should turn away from the life-giver and kick all of His goodness to us back in His face. As a result, in proper and perfect justice, we stand under the judgment of God, facing an eternal hell. Into that situation Jesus Christ came. Jesus is The Christ. Jesus is the saviour. He is the Christ: the One who sorts everything out and resolves the problem of sin.

Our problem is our sins and we face eternal judgment because of them. Jesus comes as the resolver; the Christ to sort everything out. He goes to the cross and dies our death that we might never die. In Christ we can be delivered from hell and delivered to glory to share in the life of God.

We need to believe in Him. If you believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, you will be saved (see Acts 16:31). You must be saved, you must, otherwise you spend eternity in hell.

NOT SURE It may be that when you hear the question "Are you saved?" you are perplexed and you answer that you are "Not Sure". So then you must ask yourself: "Am I believing the gospel? Am I believing in Christ who died for my sins?" If you are truly believing, as a broken repentant sinner, then you are saved and don't let Satan rob you of that assurance.

"But, my believing seems weak" you respond. To which we say that it is your faith in Christ that saves. It is faith which touches Christ that brings salvation. The strength of your faith is not the issue. The fact of your faith is the issue.

"I don't feel much," is the response of another. Feelings come and go, but Christ remains eternally strong to save. If you believe in Him, you have salvation whether you feel it or not.

"I am too bad, I surely can't be saved" comes a further response. Are you a sinner? This is the question this person must face. Christ saves sinners is the wonderful truth. And if you are believing in Christ then you are saved. He saves nice sinners and foul sinners, secret sinners and open sinners. He saves all sinners. As Paul said: The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am the foremost (1 Tim. 1:15)

As we conclude let us be assured from Isaiah 45:22 that our God is a saving God. "Turn to me and be saved, all the ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other.
